

# PSP Player



## **PSP Converting Help**

1. Insert your DVD movie to be copied to your PSP.
2. Click on New and then click ok.
3. Now click on the button that says "mobile" this will bring up the mobile device (PSP) options.
4. Select the PSP and choose your quality settings and click the start button.
5. Now you will see the PSP settings. There is a lightly box with the default quality settings showing. You can change the settings by clicking the arrow next to this lightly shaded box to change the quality of the settings.
6. Once that is done the converted DVD will be stored in your DVD neXt COPY temp directory on your computer in PSP format.

## **Transfer the DVD to your PSP Help**

There are 3 ways to do this. The first is a little more work but its free if you already have the hardware on your computer which you most likely do.

1. To transfer from the DVD neXt COPY temp directory to your PSP you will need a media card reader. Most computers now days have one of these on them. It would be located on your tower or on your

laptop and it's a place where you insert memory and media cards like from your digital camera and other devices. Now inside of your PSP you should have a memory card where you store your data games and movies. You can take that out and insert it into your memory card reader on your computer. This will allow you to transfer data and your movies to it.

2. The second way that is much easier but requires a purchase of some software from [Sony USA](#) .This is called Sony Media Manager: [Sony Creative Software - Media Manager for PSP - Introduction](#) . Sony Media Manager gives you complete control of everything on your PSP from within and very easy to use software interface.

3. Follow the directions below.

1. Insert a Memory Stick into the Memory Stick slot in the left side of the PSP. Depending on how many video files you want it to hold, you may need to get a larger one than the stick that came with your system.

2. Turn on the PSP.

3. Plug a USB cable into the back of the PSP and into your PC. The USB cable needs to have a Mini-B connector on one end (this plugs into the PSP), and a standard USB connector on the other (this plugs into the computer).


4. Scroll to the "Settings" icon on the home menu of your PSP.

5. Find the "USB Connection" icon in the "Settings" menu. Press the X button. Your PSP will display the words "USB Mode" and your PC or Mac will recognize it as a USB storage device.

6. There should be a folder called "MP\_ROOT" on the PSP Memory Stick if you formatted it on your PSP; if not, create one.

7. There should be a folder called "100MNV01" inside the "MP\_ROOT" folder, if not create it.

8. Drag and drop files into the folders just as you would save files in another folder on your computer. Video files go in the "100MNV01" folder.

9. Disconnect your PSP by first clicking on the  on the PSP Player, or on the PC "Safely Remove Hardware" on the bottom task bar of a PC usually on the lower right hand side, down by the clock. Then unplug the USB cable and press the circle button to return to the home menu.

## IPOD Player



### **iPod Converting Help**

1. Insert your DVD movie to be copied to your iPod.
2. Click on New and then click ok.
3. Now click on the button that says "mobile" this will bring up the mobile device (iPod) options.
4. Select the iPod and choose your quality settings and click the start button.
5. Now you will see the IPOD settings. There is a lightly box with the default quality settings showing. You can change the settings by clicking the arrow next to this lightly shaded box to change the quality of the settings.
6. Once that is done the converted DVD will be stored in your DVD neXt COPY temp directory on your computer in iPods format.

### **Transfer the DVD to your iPod Help**

You need to have iTunes installed on your computer to manage content on your iPod. All you have to do is open iTunes up, then drag and drop the DVD movie you just converted to iPod format from your DVD neXt COPY temp directory folder to your iPods movies folder in iTunes.

## **Zune Player**



### **Zune Player Converting Help**

- 1.** Insert your DVD movie to be copied to your Zune Player.
- 2.** Click on New and then click ok.
- 3.** Now click on the button that says "mobile" this will bring up the mobile device options.
- 4.** Select the iPod and choose your quality settings and click the start button.
- 5.** Now you will see the IPOD settings. There is a lightly box with the default quality settings showing. You can change the settings by clicking the arrow next to this lightly shaded box to change the quality of the settings.
- 6.** Once that is done the converted DVD will be stored in your DVD neXt COPY temp directory on your computer in iPods format.

You will need to have Zune Player software installed on your computer to manage content on your Zune Player.
